Here's how to set it up

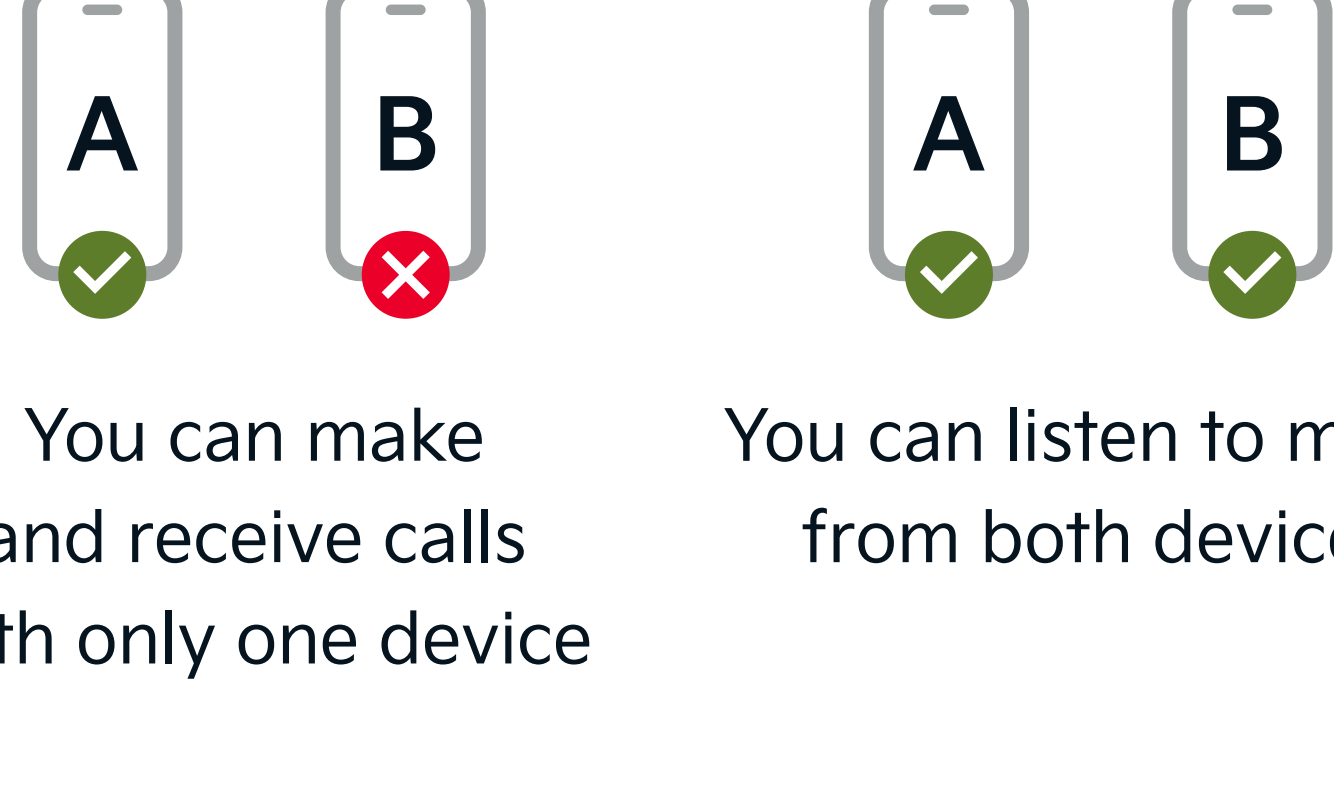


In the infotainment system,
select **Settings** and go to **Phone Connections**.



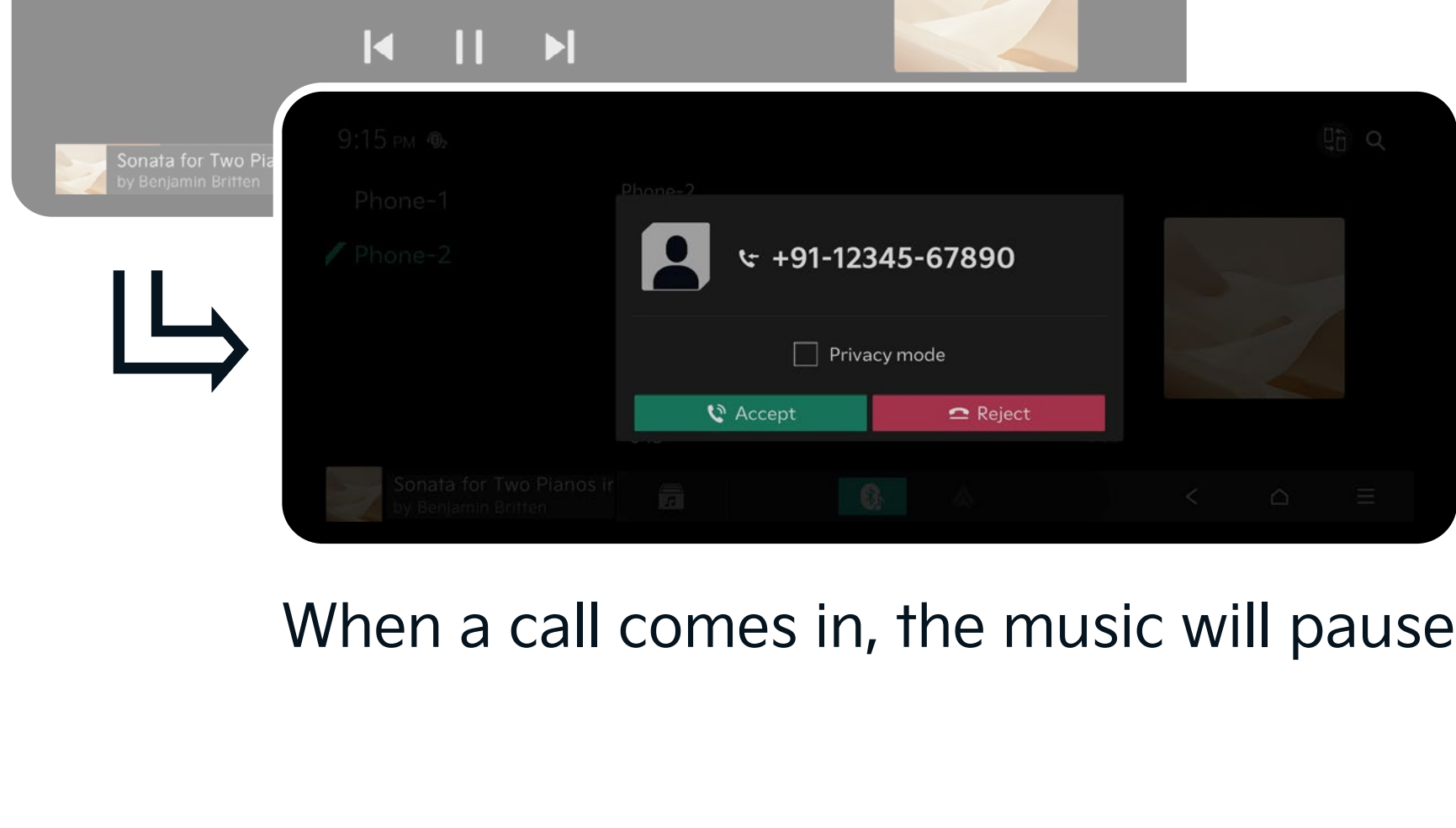
Register all connectable devices.

from both devices

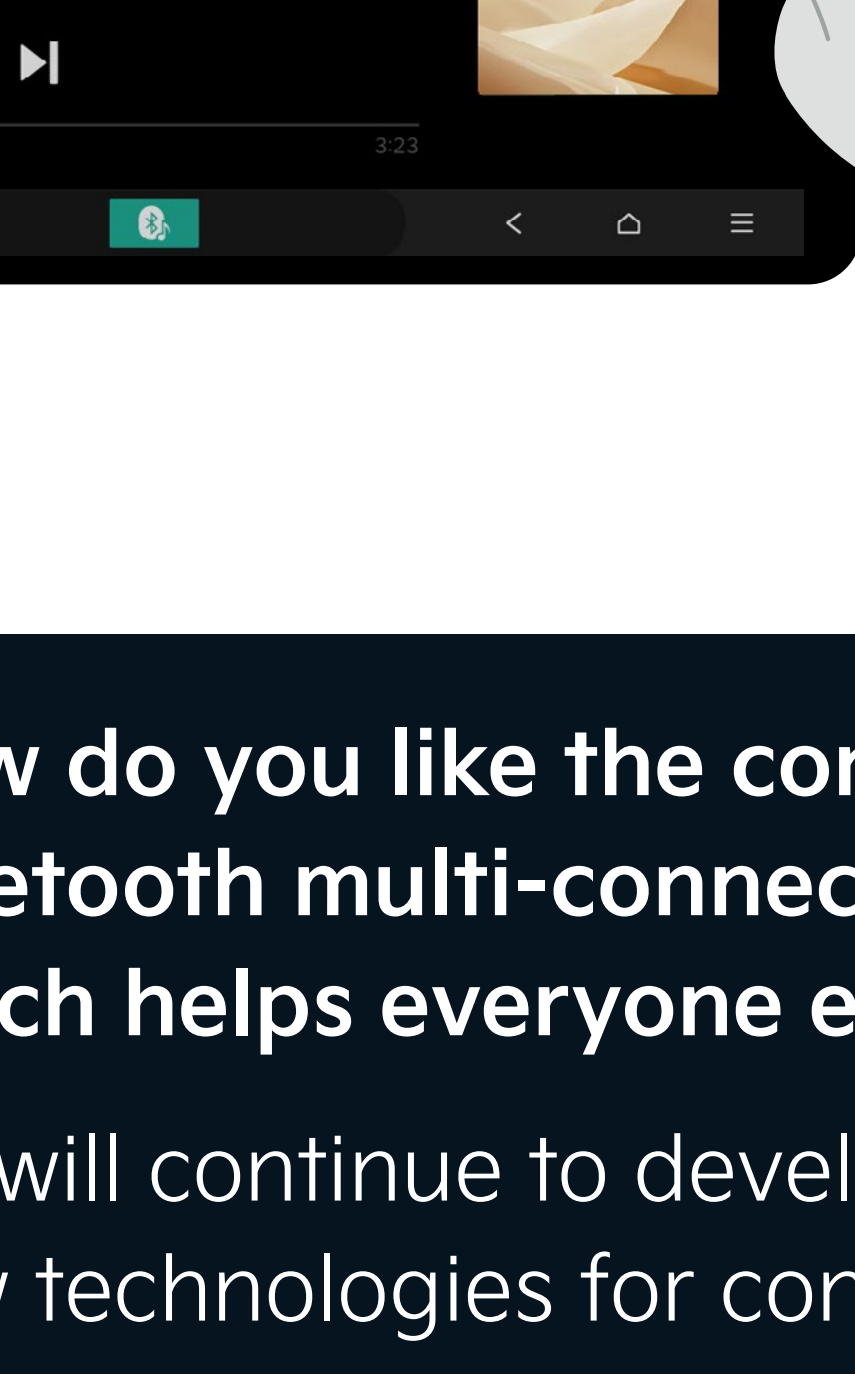


When a call comes in, the music will pause.
