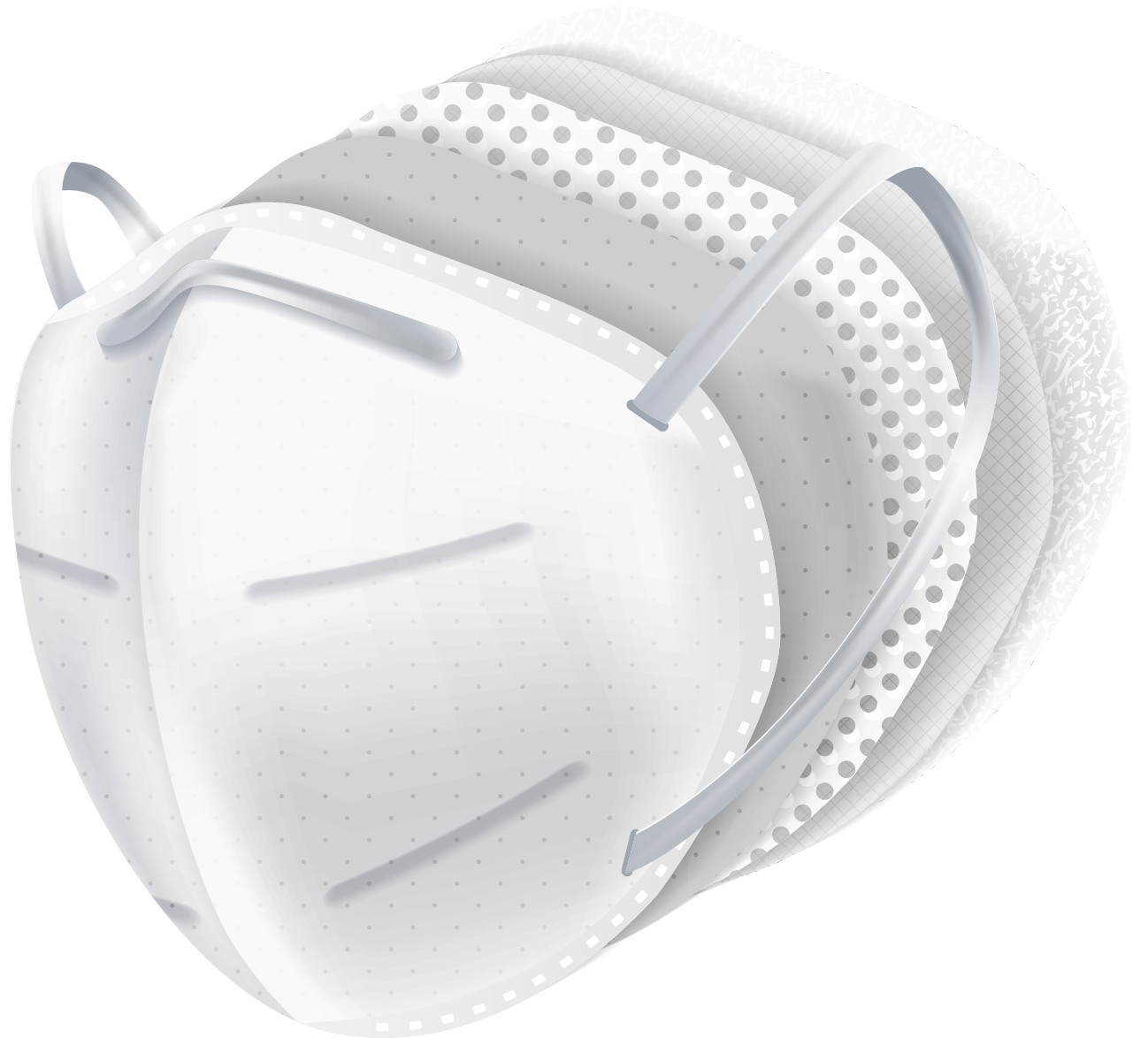

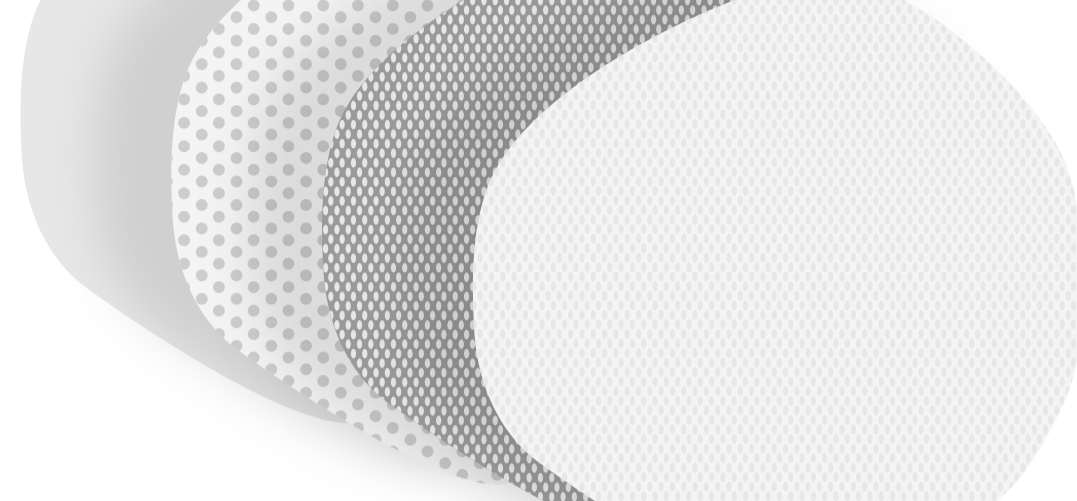
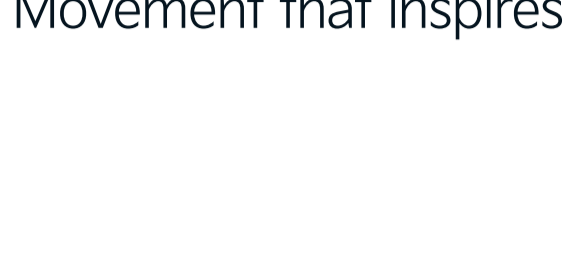

Fresh Air

Masks cover your mouth and nose to protect your body from dust and foreign substances. In vehicles we have a climate control air filter.



The climate control air filter filters out dust and pollen that come in from the outside.

What Happens If the Filter Gets Clogged After Prolonged Use?



A decrease in the fan speed by the climate control system.



Windows may fog up when switched to the outside air position.

Problems That May Arise If the Filter Is Contaminated



Respiratory damage & Weakened immunity

- Poor air quality in the vehicle due to inflow of contaminated air.
- Formation of mould and bacteria in the damp filter.

Climate control system & overload and failure

- Overload of the blower motor.
- Increased noise and reduced performance.

Climate Control Air Filter Replacement Cycle

Every 12 Months / 10,000km



In cities with severe air pollution



Driving on dusty unpaved roads

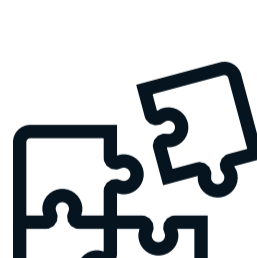


Frequent driving on hills



Early replacement may be required.

Optimal thickness and surface area

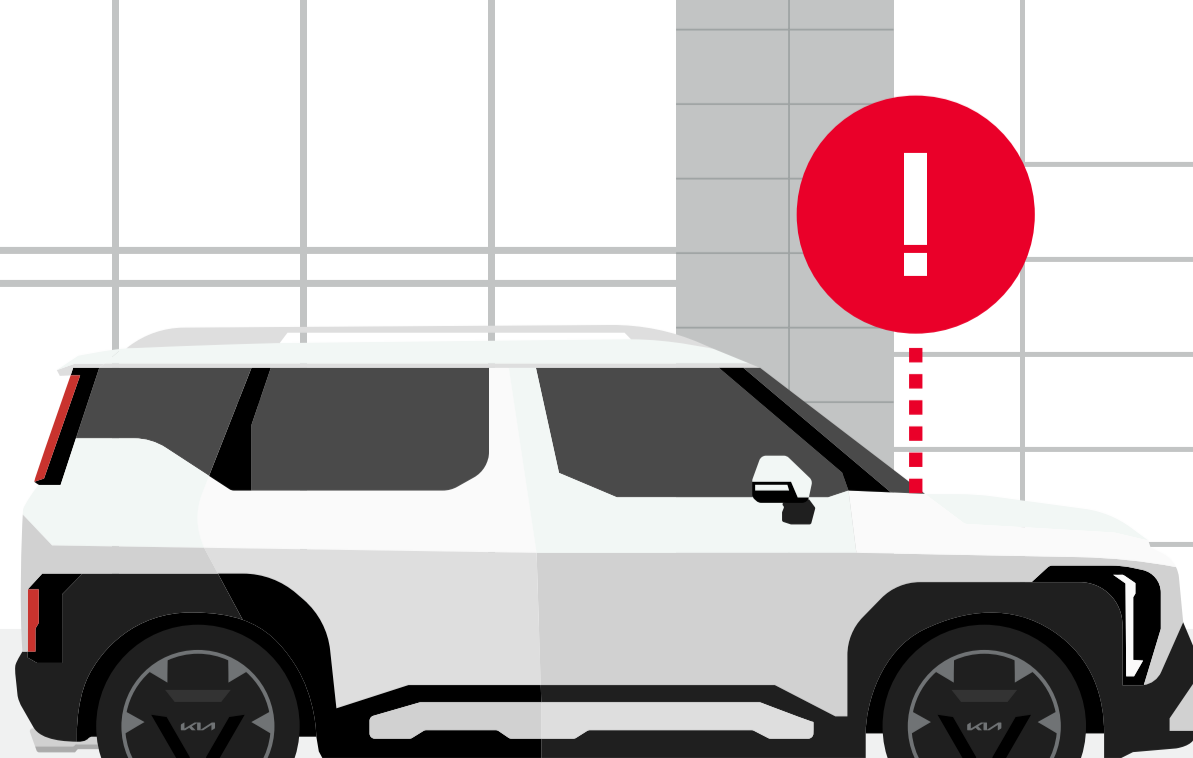


Ideal number and size of pores

Tips for maintaining your climate control air filter

1. Refrain from opening windows on days with high levels of fine dust.
⇒ Pre-emptively block polluted air.
2. Periodically switch to the outside air position.
⇒ Continuous use of recirculated air will shorten the filter's life.
3. Turn on the after-blow function. (where available)
⇒ Remove moisture and residual water from inside the climate control system.
