### A. 4.3-inch TFT-LCD cluster


The supervision cluster helps you stay focused and informed, with data like remaining distance to empty and fuel consumption, navigation cues, and outside temperature.




# WHERE FIRST-CLASS IS IN THE 2<sup>ND</sup> ROW

### B. VIP lounge seat switches

Separate buttons adjust recline, seat base, and extendable leg rest. A central button engages relaxation features, while one-touch relaxation and return buttons are located at the top for instant comfort at your fingers.

### C. Relaxation mode

In Relaxation mode, the seatback reclines, the front of the seat base tilts upward, and the leg support lifts and extends. All to help you stretch out and relax.




### Drive mode selector


### Safe Exit Assist (SEA) with Power Sliding Door

If you attempt to open the power sliding door as a vehicle approaches from the rear, SEA will keep the door locked and sound a buzzer for one second, so you can check for traffic and try opening it again once it is safe.

### Rear Cross-Traffic Collision-Avoidance Assist (RCCA)

Rear corner radars detect the presence of cross traffic, from the right or left, in the lane the Carnival is backing into. If a vehicle is detected, and audible and visual warnings go unheeded, emergency braking is applied automatically.






### Surround View Monitor (SVM)

When maneuvering in confined spaces, multiple cameras give you a zoomable, 360° overhead view around the vehicle, so you can steer and park with confidence.




### Parking Distance Warning (PDW)













